Research + Technical Development

Like any design firm that strives to innovate, HTDSTUDIO takes much pride in the opportunities it gets to create new architectural languages, statements and typologies. Whether limited or open competition, RFP or one-off research project, we use these exercises not only to affirm our expertise and strength as a design firm, but also to develop a steadily expanding repertoire of design elements and details. Process

Our primary concern is the development of a design that not only enhances the functions of the client's operations but also delineates the appropriate visual imagery. To assure clients' understanding of our proposals we use rendered perspective color drawings, three-dimensional models and other visual communication techniques as appropriate. During the design process we engage and coordinate with mechanical and structural engineers to assure proper environmental control and structural integrity. We coordinate all building code and zoning issues with our work and prepare the required drawings and documents for filing requisite governing agencies.

We provide fully detailed construction drawings and specifications based on an approved design as well as required contracts with the builder. Our approach to contract documents is to develop the most complete and coordinated documents possible to protect our clients from unexpected surprises during the construction phase. We offer assistance in obtaining realistic pricing through owner-supplied contractors, contractors supplied by us or through construction managers. We negotiate with contractors on the client's behalf until the cost and schedule meet their requirements.

Cost Control

To control costs throughout the project we obtain contractor supplied cost estimates during the design and contract document phases. In this way, the scope of work may be adjusted before construction is imminent and before changes affect the schedule adversely. In addition, our complete and coordinated documents have reduced cost overruns during construction to an absolute minimum.

We offer additional design services such as specifying and coordinating furniture, carpeting, signage, window treatment, art programs, accessories and other items as required. We also design custom furniture, fixtures, lighting and complete brand identity programs including websites and stationery.
